Scenario:

A local school corporation is planning to open up a new K-8 school. They already plan on including classroom sets of computers in their technology plan, but are unsure as to what else they should include in the new school.

In your presentation to the School Corporation, you will need to analyze the tool in depth according to the items listed above, as well as other factors you discover during your analysis. You will also need to come to a decision as to whether or not you would recommend this tool to the School Corporation, and justify your decision.
